USAGE

These two German verbs look almost identical, but the same way as their English counterparts to adopt and adapt. **Adoptieren** means to adopt (e.g. child, attitude etc.). **Adaptieren** translates as to adapt (i.e. to conform oneself to conditions). However, in Austrian German, **adaptieren** can also mean to adapt an apartment etc.
